

ORYA Winter Basketball League 2018-19

Game Rules for Ages 11 & 12 Boys

1. High school rules will govern with the following recognized exceptions.
2. Basketball size: 29.5 (regulation)
3. Regulation goal
4. Game length: Four(4) 6-minute quarters.
5. The clock will stop for time-outs, free throws, out of bounds and any injuries during the course of the game. Running clock is invoked after a 20-point lead and will only stop at time outs. If lead drops below to 10 or below, return to a standard regulation clock. Clock will stop after made baskets for final 1:00 minute of game.
6. Time outs: 3-30 second & 2-60 second
7. 3 second lane violation
8. Half times will be 3 minutes with 1 minute between quarters.
9. The goal is to have no forfeits. If fewer than five players are in attendance for a team, the game will be played 4 on 4 (if less than 4, team must forfeit).
10. Each player must play a minimum of nine (9) minutes per game unless a team has more than 10 players in such case the minimum is eight (8) minutes for a roster of 11, seven (7) minutes for a roster of 12, etc... Players must check in/out at scorers table.
11. Teams can't press with a 15-point lead (teams will receive two verbal warnings with 3rd resulting in a technical). If lead drops to 10 or below, press can continue.
12. If game ends in a tie, 3:00 minutes for 1st and 2nd overtime. If after 2nd overtime the game is still tied, each team shoots 5 foul shots to determine the winner (must use a different player for each shot). If the game remains tied then each team shall select one (1) player for a sudden death shoot-off. **PLAYOFF GAMES WILL NOT USE FREE THROWS BUT OVERTIMES UNTIL ONE TEAM WINS.**

Game Rules for Ages 11 & 12 Boys

ADDITIONAL LEAGUE RULES:

- All teams given 7 team fouls per half, then bonus is invoked (double bonus after 10 team fouls in a half).
- All players are given 5 personal fouls, then player is no longer eligible to play for the rest of the game
- Players and coaches can be suspended from games or the entire season depending on the severity of the offence. A no tolerance-fighting rule is in effect. Coaches and/or players receiving 2 technical fouls in one game will be removed from facility (offender will be asked to leave the current game and will sit for one additional game and action will be reviewed by the Basketball Committee). A player or coach that is suspended for two games is suspended for the remainder of the season.
- Player receiving 1 flagrant foul will be removed from the play for 2 quarters of the current game. If player receives a second flagrant foul anytime during the remainder of the season, player will be removed from the current game and suspended for the next scheduled game. Players actions will also be reviewed by the basketball committee, and if deemed necessary, player may be suspended for remainder of season.
- Parents may also be removed from the facility. If this occurs, the offending parent will be asked to leave the gym immediately and their action will be reviewed by the basketball committee.
- Rosters must be provided at the beginning of season and entered into the books prior to each game (includes name, birthdate & jersey number).
- All players are required to wear team shirt.
- A player cannot participate in the game if they arrive after the 3rd quarter begins.
- No jewelry is permitted to be worn at any time during a game. No player will be permitted on floor unless jewelry is removed.
- Players cannot play on multiple rosters (no roster jumping).
- If a team is down players due to sickness, availability, etc. (<6 players present)... you may pull from younger age group to fill in – no “picking up players from stands”. Players playing up from a younger team may only play up 5 times total in the season (including tournament play). The coach is responsible for notifying the Basketball Director when players play up for their team.
- Unofficial team practices away from sanctioned ORYA practice facilities are prohibited, and any violation of this rule will result in an automatic forfeit of your next scheduled game albeit regular season or tournament and your action will be reviewed by the basketball committee and the ORYA board.
- All coaches are responsible for providing a Clock Keeper (home team provides) or a Book Keeper (visitor team provides) during the game.
