

General Rules for the Rollie Bauman Practice Pavilion Use:

- 1) Any person who has been assigned the access key code is responsible for any damage that may occur during their booked time.
- 2) Parents, children, and players are not to enter the Batting Pavilion until their coach or assistant coach is at the Batting Pavilion.
- 3) Teams are not to run over their allotted time. Teams should start cleaning up their equipment 5 minutes prior to the end of their time slot, so they are ready to vacate the Batting Pavilion on time. All teams are responsible to clean up the Batting Pavilion each time they are finished with their session.
- 4) NO CLEATS are to be worn in the Pavilion.
- 5) Report any Pavilion or equipment problems to:

- 6) Nets are to be stored in the OPEN position at the end of practice.
- 7) Pitching machines are to be stored on the back wall or remain set up in the Batting Pavilion.
- 8) Other equipment is to be stored near the front (garage door side) wall.
- 9) Lights, Fans & Heat are to be turned off at the end of practice.
- 10) Do not adjust the temperature on the thermostat; the Pavilion will heat up to 55 degrees in 10-15 minutes.
- 11) There is no smoking or eating sunflower seeds in the Pavilion.
- 12) When leaving please ensure the following:
 - a. All balls are in the buckets and bats have been returned to the bat rack.
 - b. All garbage is in the garbage cans.
 - c. The door is locked.
 - d. All pitching machines are turned off.
 - e. The heat, lights and fans are turned off.
- 13) Safety Issues:
 - a. Any individual not practicing or assisting with practice MUST stay within the designated (behind the net wall) area to avoid injury.
 - b. All players in the Pavilion area must wear batting helmets if anyone is swinging a bat in the Pavilion.
 - c. No players may swing bats without the consent of their coaches.
 - d. No pitching machines may be turned on without the team coach or assistant coach being present.
 - e. L screens must be used for all hardball hitting (live or machine pitch).
 - f. On deck hitters are to wait OUTSIDE the nets, and should NOT be swinging their bats.
 - g. No unsupervised swinging should occur outside the nets.
 - h. No unsupervised hitting at ANY time.
 - i. No bouncing balls off the wall.
 - j. There may be a maximum of three hitting stations for T-work or soft toss in each Pavilion.
 - k. Use hooks for clothing and bat bags.
 - l. Keep the floor free from all obstacles at all times.
 - m. Be sure the garage door is protected before throwing outside the nets.
 - n. Inspect all areas of the Pavilion before and after using the Pavilion.
 - o. Maximize the safety of all participants.
- 14) Reserving the Batting Pavilion will be done according to the rules posted on the website: www.blbaseball.com. The Pavilion can be reserved for 30 or 60 minutes and may need to be shared with a total of five players.

15) Coaches and Assistant coaches may book the Batting Pavilion in the off-season free of charge for all registered players using the guidelines above.

16) Non-Burlington Little League players (i.e.: any outside users) can book the Pavilion for \$25 per hour. To reserve the Batting Pavilion, please contact: Josh Dow at (262) 210-9878 or joshdow12@gmail.com.

17) FAILURE TO SHOW UP AT THE PAVILION DURING TIMES YOU HAVE IT RESERVED WILL RESULT IN THE LOSS OF USE OF THE PAVILION. PLEASE ONLY RESERVE IT FOR TIMES YOU WILL USE IT.

I will not allow anyone access to the Pavilion without the scheduled responsible coach/person ON SITE.
